This action for forfeiture of public office and position and permanent disqualification from public office, having been opened to this Court by Anne Milgram, Attorney General of New Jersey, (Leslie-Ann M. Justus, Deputy Attorney General, appearing) arising from the conviction of defendant Sharpe James, in the jury trial in the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey on April 16, 2008, to five counts of fraud, contrary to 18 U.S.C. §§ 371, 666(a)(1)(b) and 2, 1341 and 2 and 1346 (counts one through five), and the crimes of which Sharpe James was found guilty constituting offenses involving dishonesty, being equivalent to at least third-degree crimes

under New Jersey law, and being offenses that involved or touched upon his offices as Mayor of Newark.

IT IS ON THIS 11<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2008, ORDERED, that Sharpe James, forfeits, effective April 16, 2008, any public employment, office or position held by him, including but not limited to his former positions as Mayor of the City of Newark and State Senator; and it is further

ORDERED that as a result of the above-referenced conviction, Sharpe James is forever disqualified from holding any office or position of honor, trust, or profit under this State or any of its administrative or political subdivisions, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:51-2d.
